**Fancy Drill Special Event**

**Drill Teams may enter Only ONE of the following categories:**

Basic Drill Demonstrations -- 2 minutes

Fancy Drill Competition – 4 minutes

     Fancy Drill Teams must consist of at least 3 members.

     Drill Team members must be in Class A Uniforms

     Fancy Drill Teams will have more latitude to use familiar drill commands; however, teams will still be **required to demonstrate the basic commands** listed, as well as individually created routines and moves that will be judged according to the standard rubric below.

**These Basic Commands listed must all be performed at some point in your routine and may be interspersed with your creative moves:**

Fall In

Dress Right Dress/Ready Front

Cover/Recover

Present Arms/Order Arms

Left Face

Right Face

About Face

Parade Rest

Mark Time March

Attention \*

Hand Salute

Forward March

Column Left March

Column Right March

Right Flank March

Left Flank March

Rear March

Halt

Dismissed

# **Fancy Drill Routine:**

**4 minutes** to perform

Time will start when the command “**Fall In**” is given

For every 1-20 seconds over the allotted time limit, 5 points will be deducted from the total score

Time stops when the command “Dismissed” is given

(After “Dismissed” is given, leave the drill area immediately or a time penalty may still be assessed.)

**Include at least 3 intricate moves**

**Include at least 2 Combined moves at a single command**

**Use of implements (objects other than the Pathfinder’s body; ie: rifle, talking stick, flags, etc.) may be used, but should not interfere with the Team’s movements.**

**Points:** *The following criteria will be used in the scoring process:*

10 Points **Uniform** – Uniformity & Compliance with NAD Class A Uniform

10 Points **Drill Captain** – Command Voice & Ability to Command Team effectively

20 Points **Creativity** – Team’s performance of commands in a smooth-flowing rhythmic manner

20 Points **Precision** – Team’s ability to perform commands uniformly with precision & sharpness

40 Points **Drill Routine** – Team’s performance of commands, use of space, and timing of movements

**Bonus Points:** 5 Points will be awarded to Drill Teams with a **leader 18 & under**

**Point Deductions:** 5 Points will be deducted for every 1-20 seconds over the time 5

Points will be deducted for each piece of equipment dropped or improperly carried

10 Points will be deducted if the team fails to demonstrate proper marching techniques

**Immediate Disqualification/Dismissal will occur if inappropriate movements are performed or inappropriate behavior displayed by team or club members.**

## **Scoring:**

The scoring of the judges will be tallied and averaged to calculate the final score. Scoring and decisions by the judges are final and are not to be argued or debated. Inappropriate or unchristian like behavior directed toward the judges or staff will result in disqualification.

Awards will be given to all teams that meet the standard for the following scoring brackets

**1st Place:** 90 to 100 Points -- At least 90% of the total points available

**2nd Place:** 80 to 89 Points -- At least 80% of the total points available

**3rd Place:** 70 to 79 Points -- At least 70% of the total points available

# Drill Team Knowledge

*The following is a list of the skills that any Pathfinder wishing to be on Drill Team will need to master:*

- >Knows right from left
- >Sharpness, doesn't hesitate execution
- >Square corners
- >In step with group
- >Listens
- >Good attitude
- >Imagination
- >Neat appearance

Has the ability to execute a series of moves smoothly and crisply.
